Description:

This is a classroom-based skills course designed to prepare the prospective fireline supervisor to undertake safe and effective fire management operations. It is the second course in a series that collectively serves to develop fire behavior prediction knowledge and skills. Fire environment differences are discussed as necessary; instructor should stress local conditions.. Topics: Environment, basic weather process; use of Belt Weather Kit, humidity, winds, keeping current weather, topographical influences, fuels, moisture, wildland fire behavior in the third dimension, wildland fire environmental factors and indicators.
