Dear Fire Academy Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the 37th Heartland Fire Academy. We hope this academy will help you in preparation for a career in the Fire Service. The Heartland Fire Academy consists of Southwestern Community College courses (FS-281F and FS-281G) and various certification courses that are accredited by the California State Fire Marshal. Upon successful completion of the Heartland Fire Academy and the additional required SFT courses, students will receive a State Fire Training Firefighter 1 Certificate, and earn seventeen (17) Southwestern Community College Fire Technology units.

The Heartland Fire Academy includes lecture-based classroom sessions on topics such as *firefighter* safety, equipment operation, fire extinguishers, forcible entry tools and techniques, lifting and hoisting equipment, fire hose, hose nozzles and fittings, hose evolutions, ladders, breathing apparatus, fire control, fire prevention, and more. Manipulative classes give recruits the opportunity to practice skills taught in the classroom.

ACADEMY INFORMATION

- Academy 37 is a 540-hour course; start date will be Monday, August 26th, 2024 at 7:00 am
- This course meets Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Class locations will be the Heartland Fire Training Facility and other off-site locations
- Students are expected to be present at each of the required academy training sessions
- Academy fees (due by August 26th, 2024)

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years of age at time of academy start date
- EMT-B or Public Safety-First Aid (completed by August 18th 2024)
- High school graduate or equivalent (GED)

- ICS IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, IS-800
- CPAT completion no older than 12 months at time of acceptance to academy

SELECTION PROCESS

- Medical Examination: Successful candidates will be required to complete a Respiratory Clearance Doctor Exam; specific to OSHA requirements.
 - o The medical examination is completed at the candidate's expense; approximate cost is \$165.00. An exam can be done at San Diego Sports Medicine, 6699 Alvarado Rd. Suite 2100, San Diego CA 92120. 619-229-3909.
 - o Agency required medical examination can be used in lieu of San Diego Sports Medicine physical
- Mask Fit Test. All successful candidates will be required to:
 - o Provide a copy of an annual Mask Fit Test.
- Physical Abilities Test: Candidates must have a valid CPAT card *dated no older than 12 months before the academy start date*. See http://www.cffjac.org/go/jac/cpat/ for more information.
 - o Agency approved physical ability test can be used in lieu of CPAT.

CONDUCT

The Academy is conducted in a paramilitary format and every effort will be made for the success of all candidates. Candidates are expected to adhere to all rules of conduct which include appropriate appearance and grooming standards

PHYSICAL TRAINING

Physical Training is an important component of the Academy. All candidates must be in good physical condition before entering the Academy. At a minimum, a candidate should be able to perform to the following standards on the first day of the Academy: 1.5-mile run / 3 Pull-ups / 25 Pushups in one minute / 30 Sit-Ups in one minute
